Oakland University is offering 1-2 graduate credits for MABE members attending the 2008 MABE Annual Institute scheduled for May 20-21.

**Course Description:**

This is a 2-day conference that provides break-out workshops with diverse group of topics for the participants. The theme of for this institute or conference is “Bi-literacy: The Power of Two.” Through the workshop sessions, participants are expected to write a report on how the sessions that they have attended are relevant to their work or can be applied in their classrooms.

**Requirements:**

1. Write a 3 -5 paged report on what they have learned and apply it to their work.
  - a. Workshop’s content that is relevant to classrooms.
  - b. Keynote speakers’ content that is relevant to participants’ work or classrooms.
  - c. Whether they agree or disagree with any methods or interventions presented. Why or how they would handle it differently.
2. The report will be due two weeks after the conference.
3. Grading: Based on the report:
  - a. 70% Content & session participation
  - b. 30% Grammar, spelling & mechanics
